Denver Women's Chorus will 'Feel Like Dancing' on June 5

Denver CO (May 5) — Denver Women's Chorus will "Feel Like Dancing" at their dance-inspired Spring Concert on Saturday, June 5, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. at Montview Boulevard Presbyterian Church, 1980 Dahlia Street at Montview Boulevard in Denver. DWC's special guests will be the swing-dance team, the Woodside Jumpers. Advance-sale tickets are \$20 (adults), \$18 (seniors, 55 and over), \$16 (students, 13-21); children 12 and under are free when accompanied by an adult.

Among the highlights of DWC's vocal selections will be Irving Berlin's "Cheek To Cheek," Greg Jasperse's *Voice Dance*, Zoltan Kodaly's "See The Gypsies," Orleans's "Dance With Me," and Linda Spevacek's *Danza*.

DWC's special guests, the Woodside Jumpers, has been wowing audiences across Colorado and the U.S. for over seven years. From flips to kicks and spins their performances have it all, and will leave the audience wanting more! The Woodside Jumpers are led by International Champion swing dancers and teachers Joe DeMers and Nelle Hatley. Joe and Nelle have been in competitive dance since 2003 and have taken several National Championship titles while also dancing on the four-time International Championship team, 23 Skidoo.
