Denver CO (December 15) - “Girls Rock the Radio,” Denver Women’s Chorus Winter Concert, will be presented Saturday, January 22, 2011 at 2 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. at L2 Arts and Culture Center (1477 Columbine Street at Colfax Avenue) in Denver.

Tickets are \$20 (adults), \$16 (students); children 12 and under are free when accompanied by an adult. (These are ADVANCE ticket prices; ticket prices will be \$2 higher at the door on the day of performance.)

Whether it’s been on broadcast radio, Walkmans, Internet radio, or iPods, women performers have made those media ROCK and the Denver Women’s Chorus shows the different ways that women have used the media to their advantage, giving their voices a place to be heard!

The program will feature Roger Emerson’s “Girls Rock” medley, which includes Avril Lavigne’s “Sk8er Boi” and “Complicated,” Jesse Harris’ “Don’t Know Why,” and Sheryl Crow’s “Soak Up the Sun” and a medley of Madonna favorites, “Express Yourself.”

Other selections are the Andrews Sisters’ “Boogie-Woogie Bugle Boy,” Ben E. King’s “Stand By Me,” Etta James’ “At Last,” Paul McCartney’s “When I’m Sixty-four,” and Willie Nelson/Patsy Cline’s “Crazy.”
