Denver Gay Men's Chorus auditions announced

Denver CO (August 17) — The Denver Gay Men's Chorus (DGMC) will audition new members during the week of September 13.

Auditions usually consist of your singing something familiar, like "America" (AKA "God Save the Queen") or "You Are My Sunshine" (AKA "Sie sind mein Sonnenschein"), checking your vocal range, and testing your note-matching ability.

Auditionees will be invited to "Audition Us" for the first half of our September 13 Rehearsal; you need to have contacted DGMC prior to the September 13 Rehearsal.

DGMC's Holiday 2009 Concert, "Let it Ring! Let it Swing! Let it Snow!," is scheduled for December 5 at Highlands Ranch's St. Andrew UMC and December 11 and 12 at Denver's Montview Boulevard Presbyterian Church; our special guests will be the Rocky Mountain Ringers handbell choir.

DGMC's Spring 2010 Concert, "Hollywood Confidential: DGMC Goes to the Movies" will be May 7, 8, 14, and 15 at Montview Boulevard Presbyterian Church.

The Chorus regularly rehearses Sunday evenings at Christ Church United Methodist at 690 Colorado Boulevard from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.
