DWC's Take Note! presents their Holiday Concert 'I've Got My Love to Keep Me Warm' on December 19

Denver CO (November 13) – The Denver Women's Chorus small ensemble Take Note! will present their Holiday Concert, "I've Got My Love to Keep Me Warm," on Saturday, December 19, 2009 at 2 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. at Christ Church United Methodist, 690 Colorado Boulevard at Seventh Avenue in Denver. The special guests of Take Note! will be the Denver Gay Men's Chorus ensemble, the DGMC Ambassadors.

Tickets are \$12 in advance, \$14 at door; seniors (over 55) and students (13-21) are \$10 in advance, \$12 at door; children under 12 are free when accompanied by an adult. Tickets for "I've Got My Love to Keep Me Warm" and all RMAA events may be purchased at Wild Flowers at 12th Avenue and Madison in Denver, at Poor Richard's Bookstore at 320 N. Tickets will be available at the door on the day of the concert at Christ Church United Methodist.

Among the highlights of Take Note's Holiday Concert will be (of course) Irving Berlin's "I've Got My Love to Keep Me Warm," the popular Andy-Williams classic "Most Wonderful Time of the Year," "Santa Claus is Coming to Town" (observing its 75th birthday), "O Tannenbaum," and Michael Praetorius' "Lo, How a Rose E're Blooming." Take Note! is known for its challenging, moving, and humorous selection arrangements." As at all Take Note! Holiday Concerts, there'll be coffee, punch, and treats to nosh after each concert!

Take Note's director is Joy Jenkins, who has a master's degree in vocal performance from the University of Kansas. She has been with DWC and Take Note! since 2002, and became DWC's assistant director in 2005. Joy sings with the women's ensemble "Safonia."
