January 2010 brings **THREE RMAA** shows!

Denver CO (December 26) - Start your year right, with music and song! Rocky Mountain Arts Association has three ensembles performing this January: Mosaic Youth Chorus, Denver Women's Chorus, and Gravity Defied Theatre all have January events scheduled!

Mosaic Youth Chorus will present "The Warmth of Winter," an evening marking the joys and sorrows of winter on January 9, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. at Christ Church United Methodist, 690 Colorado Boulevard at Seventh Avenue in Denver. This is a free concert with a suggested donation of \$10 for adults over 21.

"The Warmth of Winter" will feature some well known pieces such as "Wade in the Water" and "This Little Light of Mine," but also feature pieces possibly new to your ears that paint pictures of the changes in nature that happen during winter. "From an Irish Cabin" speaks to the comfort that a fire offers on a cold night. "I Am the River" reminds us how we often get lost in the chaos winter brings, but if we take time to relax we find the calm that we seek.

Mosaic Youth Chorus is Rocky Mountain Arts Association's safe-space chorus for gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender, queer, and questioning youth and their straight friends, age 14 to 20. Mosaic's goal is to provide a safe space for youth simply to be themselves while surrounded by positive adult and peer role models.

Denver Women's Chorus will present their all-Broadway Winter Concert, "Broadway: What's Old Is New Again" on Saturday, January 23, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. and Sunday, January 24, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at First Plymouth Congregational Church, 3501 South Colorado Boulevard, in Englewood. Tickets are \$20 (adults), \$18 (seniors, 55 and over), \$16 (students, 13-21); children 12 and under are free when accompanied by an adult.

The concert will present some of your favorite Broadway melodies (“Aquarius/Let The Sunshine In,” “Don’t Rain on My Parade,” “Send In the Clowns,” “What I Did For Love”), expose you to some hidden jewels (“Adelaide’s Lament,” “No Day But Today,” “Mama Who Bore Me,” “How Could I Ever Know”), present a series of songs from leading ladies that stopped their shows, as well as a medley of memorable songs from Broadway’s third-longest-running musical, Les Misérables.

Gravity Defied Theatre will present “You’re a Good Man, Charlie Brown” at Aurora Fox Arts Center’s Studio Theatre (9900 E. Colfax Avenue) for three weekends in January: January 15, 16, 22, 23, 29, and 30 at 7:00 p.m. and January 17, 24, and 31 at 4:00 p.m. Tickets are \$20 adult, \$15 for seniors (over 55) and students (13 to 21), and \$10 for children (12 and under).

From a peaceful bright, sunlit morning to a serene, starlit night, our favorite Peanuts characters play through their day and cope with their usual childhood trials, trying to find their own piece of happiness; in the end, they find that friends and the simple joys around them are what truly brings happiness.
