RMAA presents LUNAFEST on October 23

Denver (October 2) – Rocky Mountain Arts Association will present LUNAFEST®, an evening of short films by, for, and about women on Friday, October 23 at 7:00 p.m. at the Eisenhower Chapel, 293 Roslyn Street at Lowry in Denver to benefit Denver Women's Chorus.

LUNAFEST is filled with stories of reflection and whimsy, hope and humor, grace and perseverance; LUNAFEST films are renowned for celebrating the talents and stories of women.

LUNAFEST's films have won industry awards and audience praise, and the films selected for this season share this brilliance, from quirky animation to touching documentaries, the ten selected films are incredibly diverse in both style and subject matter, united by a common thread of exceptional storytelling by, for, and about women.

The films in LUNAFEST include "A Summer Rain," "A Vida Politica," "Anjali," "DIY: Emancipation 101," "Monday Before Thanksgiving," "Omelette," "Plastic," "Roz (And Joshua)," "The Kinda Sutra," and "The McCombie Way."

LUNAFEST is in its ninth year and was started in 2000 by LUNA, the makers of the Whole Nutrition Bar for Women to promote women filmmakers, raise awareness for women's issues, and support worthy women's nonprofit organizations throughout the U.S. and Canada. Thus far, LUNAFEST, has raised over \$200,000 for Breast Cancer Fund and over \$470,000 for other women's nonprofit organizations.

100 percent of all proceeds are donated to charity – 15 percent to the Breast Cancer Fund and the remaining 85 percent of proceeds to RMAA's Denver Women's Chorus. LUNAFEST is completely funded by LUNA and run by a group of LUNA employees.
